1.1	<p>The definition of State Library of Queensland Weekend and Late Shift Operations Staff as defined has been updated.</p> <p>These are administrative changes to reflect the current organisational structure work units and naming conventions. It does not change the scope of the definition or roles covered.</p>

Provisions Applicable to Certain Professional Staff Employed in the Department of Communities, Disability Services and Seniors	<p>The student supervision allowance previously provided for in this appendix has been moved into a new appendix as it does not apply to employees in this department.</p> <p>It applies to employees in the Department of Child Safety, Seniors and Disability Services (Seniors and Disability Services Only as specified) – please see Explanatory Document for this group for information on this allowance.</p> <p>Therefore, the removal has no impact to staff in this department as no employees would be eligible to make a claim for this allowance.</p>
