### Victorian Government case study

#### Examples of possible Inquiry requests for information

These likely Queensland examples have been informed by requests received by the Victorian Government from the <u>Victorian Yoo-rrook Justice Commission</u>.

#### General requests that may apply to multiple agencies

**Example:** Provide to the Inquiry relevant documentation and information about the theft, misappropriation and destruction of cultural knowledge and property.

#### Requests that may be more specific to particular agencies

**Example:** Provide to the Inquiry relevant documentation and information about unfair policies and practices relating to policing, youth and criminal justice, incarceration, detention and the broader legal system

**Example:** Provide to the Inquiry relevant documentation and information about unfair policies and practices relating to health and healthcare.

# Requests that may be particularly relevant to DSDSATSIP as the agency responsible for Queensland's historical 'Protection Acts', but evidence of which likely also permeated across agencies

**Example:** Provide to the Inquiry relevant documentation and information about protectionist and assimilationist policies, including forced removal of children and attempts to eradicate language, culture or identity.

## Some requests may be specific to regions, locations or time periods

**Example:** Provide to the Inquiry relevant documentation and information on Government practices at Cherbourg and their impacts.
