# Commencement of modern awards

#### New modern awards

The Queensland Industrial Relations Commission (QIRC) is in the final stages of the award modernisation process. The object of the process has been to develop modern awards that, together with the Queensland Employment Standards (QES), are simple to understand, easy to apply and provide for a fair minimum safety net of enforceable conditions of employment.

The award modernisation process will result in the replacement of 47 pre-modernisation awards with 26 modern awards to cover employees in the Queensland public sector. A list of modern awards and the pre-modernisation awards they relate to is provided on the next page.

### Key features of modern awards

While many entitlements will not change as the public sector transitions to modern awards, there are some notable differences compared to pre-modernisation awards:

- New structure and format
- Updated terminology
- Supplementation of QES referenced throughout
- Greater consistency in standard clauses
- Automatic increases of expense related allowances
- Annual leave to be paid at the rate received immediately prior to taking the leave
- Removal of reliance on directives for certain award conditions

Further, modern awards will capture all provisions from the Family Leave (Queensland Public Sector) Award - State 2012 not provided by the QES, to enable that award to be repealed in due course.

It should also be noted that the QIRC have determined it inappropriate for an award to refer to a directive for conditions such as overtime meal allowance and excess travel. Instead, modern awards will contain safety net provisions for these entitlements alongside a note to alert the reader that a relevant directive may also exist. Interaction rules for directives and awards are provided in section 687 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1999* and section 52 of the *Public Service Act 2008*.

#### What next?

Although modern awards currently *operate*, they will only *apply* to an employee once a new certified agreement that covers that employee commences. For a large part of the public service, this will be when the *State Government Entities Certified Agreement 2015* (Core CA) is certified in mid-2016. Until then, employees continue to be covered by their relevant pre-modernisation award and certified agreement.

Agencies are encouraged to review the modern awards that will apply to them and prepare to implement any necessary changes. To assist, attached are summaries of the changes for the two main public service awards (Queensland Public Service Officers and Other Employees Award – State 2015 and General Employees (Queensland Government Departments) and Other Employees Award – State 2015).
